CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE W. WEEKS  
TRAIL, OREGON 97541

confirms the right to use the waters of ELK CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 7.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

The right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1894.

The right is limited to not more than 0.178 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 7.0 ACRES  
SECTION 35  
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by certificate 15856, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 21, 1991, approving transfer application 6364.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
