CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM A. JACKSON  
BAKER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of POWDER RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 6.85 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 291. The date of priority is MARCH 28, 1869.

The use is limited to 1/40 OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Tract W (the West 100 feet thereof); 1 acre in Tract Y; Blocks 32, 16, and 26, lots 2 and 4, Block 33, Jackson's Addition to Baker, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at Page 4261, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on August 28, 1991.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
