CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JERRY E. ROBERTSON 10 PARTRIDGE LANE ST. PAUL, MINNESOTA 55127

confirms the right to use the waters of JACKSON CREEK, a tributary of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY, INCLUDING IRRIGATION OF A LAWN OR NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 50626. The date of priority is OCTOBER 31, 1988. This right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 18, T 30 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 3010 FEET SOUTH AND 780 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

It is further provided that the right allowed herein shall be limited during the period July 15 through September 30 of each year to human consumption, livestock consumption for such animals as are essential to the proper sustenance of the family, and irrigation of a non-commercial garden not to exceed one-half acre in area.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
