CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

MEDFORD, OREGON 97501

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of POWELL CREEK, for WILDLIFE.

This right was perfected under Permit 46128. The date of priority is APRIL 21, 1981. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 23, T 38 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 530 FEET NORTH AND
440 FEET WEST FROM S 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 23.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
