CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LEE SCHULTSMEIER
7165 NORTH LOCUST GROVE
MERIDIAN, IDAHO 83642

confirms the right to use the waters of PINE CREEK, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 1.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 43257. The date of priority is MAY 12, 1978. This right is limited to 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 35, T 7 S, R 47 E, W.M.; 550 FEET NORTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF NE 1/4 NE 1/4 OF SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows.

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.4 ACRES
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
