CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE RIVER, a tributary of
ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 11.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of
Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the
Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 16, at Page 523.
The date of priority is 1903.

The use is limited to 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in
case of rotation, if available at the original point of diversion:
BUNCH-SWINDEN DITCH, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 20, T 37 S, R 5 W, W.M.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 20, T 37 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1550 FEET
SOUTH AND 180 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 20.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is
as follows:

LOT 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)	8.8 ACRES
LOT 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)	3.0 ACRES
SECTION 20	
TOWNSHIP 37, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.	

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by
Certificate 64422, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT
modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director
entered December 12, 1991, approving Transfer Application 6419.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status
of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining
to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to
beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to
all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
