CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HARLAN D. WOOD, MICHAEL W. WOOD, AND LOIS H. TRUELSON

GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of APPELEGATE LAKE RESERVOIR, constructed under PERMIT R-7810, a tributary of APPELEGATE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 13.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 46416. The date of priority is AUGUST 17, 1981. This right is limited to 28.72 ACRE-FEET CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 20, T 37 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1550 FEET SOUTH AND 180 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 20; APPELEGATE DAM - S $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0287, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)	8.8 ACRES
LOT 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)	3.0 ACRES
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$	1.7 ACRES

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 63299, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 12, 1991, approving Transfer Application 6419.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
