confirms the right to store the waters of COLD CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, in SW-19 RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-9219. The dates of priority are AUGUST 3, 1981, for 0.12 ACRE-FOOT and APRIL 1, 1983, 0.12 ACRE-FOOT. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 0.24 acre-foot.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 8  
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
