confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED STREAMS 1 AND 2, tributaries of SQUAW CREEK, in WIND POND RESERVOIR, AND TRACTOR POND RESERVOIR, for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10918. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 0.04 acre-foot, BEING 0.02 ACRE-FOOT FROM EACH STREAM.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
NE 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 17  
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
