CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the TUALATIN RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 18.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-798. The date of priority is MARCH 26, 1958. This right is limited to 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE¼ NW¼, SECTION 26, T 1 S, R 2 W, W.M.; $9\frac{1}{2}$ CHAINS EAST FROM THE NE CORNER OF JOHNSON DLC 55..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE¼ NW¼ 11.0 ACRES SECTION 26

LOT 1 (SE% NE%) 7.0 ACRES SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 28972, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 10, 1992, approving Transfer Application 6485.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
