CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A DUG INFILTRATION GALLERY in the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER BASIN for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 17.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10993. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1988. This right is limited to 0.22 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The infiltration gallery is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 40 FEET NORTH AND 290 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. ALTHOUGH DECLARED HEREIN TO BE FOR SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, USE OF WATER MAY BE EXERCISED WHEN IT IS NOT PRACTICAL TO MAINTAIN A PUMP ON NORTH UMPQUA RIVER DUE TO HIGH FLOWS OF THE RIVER. THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED THE LIMITATION ALLOWED HEREIN.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 12.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 4.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.1 ACRE

SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

When required by the department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, by not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
