## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM M. LONGHURST 3950 DEL RIO ROAD ROSEBURG, OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 9.3 ACRES, DOMESTIC USE FOR 2 FAMILIES, AND LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 50946. The date of priority is JUNE 27, 1988 FOR 0.12 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.005 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE; AND JUNE 26, 1989 FOR 0.005 CFS FOR LIVESTOCK. This right is limited to 0.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 20 FEET NORTH AND 340 FEET EAST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 6.1 ACRES

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 3.1 ACRES, 2 FAMILIES & LIVESTOCK

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.1 ACRE

SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
