## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT VICK BUILDING 525 TRADE STREET SE #301 SALEM, OREGON 97310

confirms the right to use the waters of THE JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 54.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44743. The date of priority is JANUARY 25, 1980. This right is limited to 1.36 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 8 S, R 19 E, W.M.; 2560 FEET SOUTH AND 2150 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 13.5 ACRES NE 1/4 NW 1/4 16.8 ACRES SE 1/4 NW 1/4 24.1 ACRES SECTION 36 TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
