CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JIM POPSON
PO BOX 435
FORT KLAMATH, OR 97626

confirms the right to use the waters of ANNIE CREEK, a tributary of WOOD RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 3.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 449.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 46347. The date of priority is AUGUST 3, 1981. This right is limited to 2.81 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 31, T 32 S, R 7 1/2 E, W.M.; 3650 FEET NORTH AND 460 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, PROVIDED FURTHER THAT THE RIGHT ALLOWED HEREIN IS LIMITED TO ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY OF ANY PRIOR RIGHT EXISTING FOR THE SAME LAND AND SHALL NOT EXCEED THE LIMITATION ALLOWED HEREIN, AND IS FURTHER LIMITED TO A DIVERSION OF ONE ONE-HUNDRED-SIXTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 21 TO THE END OF THE IRRIGATION SEASON OF EACH YEAR FOR THE LANDS DESCRIBED AS SUPPLEMENTAL.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
