CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of TUMALO CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 46651. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 17, 1982. This right is limited to 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 10, T 18 S, R 10 E, W.M.; 120 FEET NORTH AND 510 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF NW 1/4 NE 1/4 OF SECTION 10.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 10
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
