CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DELBERT E. ATKINS
1286 ROSS INLET ROAD
COOS BAY, OREGON 97420

confirms the right to use the waters of ROSS SLOUGH, a tributary of CATCHING SLOUGH, for IRRIGATION OF 11.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 49882. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 10, 1986. This right is limited to 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 6, T 26 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 600 FEET NORTH AND 1540 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 12 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4) 5.7 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 5.3 ACRES
SECTION 6
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
