confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATING 18.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 47461. The date of priority is MARCH 31, 1983. This right is limited to 0.45 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 8 S, R 19 E, W.M.; 1350 SOUTH AND 670 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 16.1 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4 2.0 ACRES
SECTION 36
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
