CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO
FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF PENDLETON
PENDLETON, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of SNOW and THREE CREEKS, tributaries of SQUAW CREEK, for IRRIGATING 37.4 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for DESCHUTES County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 6, at Page 20. The date of priority is 1897.

The use is limited to a diversion of 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year including losses from the diversion point to the land.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


NW 1/4 SW 1/4 27.6 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 9.8 ACRES
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 55739, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 4, 1992 canceling a portion of said waster right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
