## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JERRY BOGH ROUTE 1, BOX 918 ASTORIA, OREGON 97103

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP in the SKIPANON RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION, CHEMICAL APPLICATION, TEMPERATURE CONTROL AND FLOOD HARVESTING OF 4.2 ACRES OF CRANBERRIES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-10038. The date of priority is DECEMBER 4, 1980 FOR 0.11 CFS IRRIGATION, 0.63 CFS TEMPERATURE CONTROL, 0.3 CFS FLOOD HARVESTING, AND MARCH 30, 1983 FOR 0.11 CHEMICAL APPLICATION, AND 0.79 CFS FLOOD HARVESTING. Flood Harvesting is limited to 1.09 cfs for 12 hours per day not to exceed 4.2 acre-feet per season provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 1.09 cfs. The right is limited to not more than 1.09 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the sump.

The sump is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48, SECTION 27, T 7 N, R 10 W, W.M.; 340 FEET SOUTH AND 800 FEET EAST FROM THE SE CORNER OF DLC  $^{39}$ .

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre; For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre; For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.2 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.0 ACRE
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
