CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JERRY BOGH

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WEST LAKE, for the purpose of SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION, CHEMICAL APPLICATION, TEMPERATURE CONTROL AND FLOOD HARVESTING OF 4.2 ACRES OF CRANBERRIES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47472. The date of priority is DECEMBER 4, 1980 FOR 0.11 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION, 0.63 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL, 0.3 CFS FOR FLOOD HARVESTING, AND MARCH 30, 1983 FOR 0.11 CFS FOR CHEMICAL APPLICATION, AND 0.79 CFS FOR FLOOD HARVESTING. Flood harvesting is limited to 1.09 cfs for 12 hours per day not to exceed 4.2 acre-feet per season provided the total quantity diverted shall not exceed 1.09 cfs. The right is limited to not more than 1.09 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48, SECTION 27, T 7 N, R 10 W, W.M.; 40 FEET SOUTH AND 580 FEET EAST FROM THE SE CORNER OF DLC 39.

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre; For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre; For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.2 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.0 ACRE
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 48
SECTION 27
TOWNSHIP 7 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
