CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RAY F. HOPPER ROUTE 1, BOX 2061 BANDON, OREGON 97411 SUPERSEDED BY GERT, NO.867/0

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHNSON CREEK, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM JOHNSON CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF JOHNSON CREEK, for the purposes of TEMPERATURE CONTROL, WHICH INCLUDES BOTH FROST PROTECTION AND SUMMER HEAT CONTROL, FLOOD HARVESTING OF CRANBERRIES AND IRRIGATION FOR 2.5 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 49579. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 1, 1985. The right is limited to not more than 0.375 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND BEING 0.375 CFS FOR TEMPERATURE CONTROL, 0.125 CFS FOR FLOOD HARVESTING AND 0.063 CFS FOR IRRIGATION or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 5, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 8, T 29 S, R 14 W, W.M.; JOHNSON CREEK - 90 FEET NORTH AND 1180 FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER OF SECTION 8, UNNAMED STREAM - 970 FEET NORTH AND 250 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 2.5 ACRES SECTION 8 TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
