CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

U.S. MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO DOT SPRING a tributary of THE MALHEUR RIVER, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 50358. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 18 S, R 35 E, W.M.; 1300 FEET NORTH AND 400 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 5.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 5  
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
