## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE AT PARISH CABIN CAMPGROUND.

This right was perfected under Permit 50364. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 16 S, R 33 E, W.M.; 246 FEET NORTH AND 2345 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4
SW 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
