CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to store the waters of UNNAMED STREAMS, tributaries of BLUEBUCKET CREEK, in THREE RESERVOIRS, BEING COUGAR FLAT RESERVOIR 1, COUGAR FLAT RESERVOIR 2, AND LOWER LAKE POND for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-10922. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is 0.6 ACRE-FOOT, BEING 0.2 AF IN EACH RESERVOIR.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 COUGAR FLAT 1 AND 2
SECTION 11

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
