**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST  
139 NE DAYTON STREET  
JOHN DAY, OR 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of HUNTER SPRING, TAMARACK SPRING  
O'BRIAN SPRING, RIMROCK SPRING AND BULLRUN SPRING, tributaries of LITTLE  
MALHEUR, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 50349. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983.  
This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM EACH SOURCE,  
PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES DOES NOT  
EXCEED 0.015 CFS or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion  
from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

(1) SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, T 15 S, R 36 E, W.M.; 2000 FEET SOUTH & 1900  
FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

(2) NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 19, T 15 S, R 36 E, W.M.; 2500 FEET NORTH & 900  
FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION OF SECTION 19.

(3) NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 24, T 15 S, R 36 E, W.M.; 2630 FEET NORTH & 600  
FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 24.

(4) NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 15 S, R 36 E, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH & 2400  
FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 5.

(5) SW SW, SECTION 27, T 14 S, R 36 E, W.M.; 900 FEET NORTH & 600 FEET  
EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 27.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper  
state officer.

A description of the places of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

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Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
