CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST 139 NE DAYTON STREET JOHN DAY, OR 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of JACKSON SPRING, HAMMS SPRING, SQUAW SPRING, DOLORES SPRING, DAVE SPRING AND FEATHER SPRING, tributaries of SQUAW CREEK, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 50353. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983. This right is limited to 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE, PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM ALL SOURCES DOES NOT EXCEED 0.015 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

- (1) SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 13, T 15 S, R 36 E, W.M.; 600 FEET NORTH & 900 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 13.
- (2) LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 18, T 15 S, R 37 E, W.M.; 2600 FEET NORTH & 600 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 18.
- (3) SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 9, T 15 S, R 37 E, W.M.; 700 FEET NORTH & 600 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 19.
- (4) NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 8, T 15 S, R 37 E, W.M.; 2200 FEET NORTH & 2500 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 8
- (5) LOT 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 7, T 15 S, R 37 E, W.M.; 1300 FEET NORTH AND 600 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 7.
- (6) LOT 7 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 6, T 15 S, R 37 E, W.M.; 700 FEET NORTH AND 500 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
