CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST
139 NE DAYTON STREET
JOHN DAY, OR 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of DRIBBLE SPRING, 7-UP SPRING, TUB SPRING AND HORSESHOE SPRING, tributaries of NORTH FORK MALHEUR RIVER, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 50348. The date of priority is OCTOBER 11, 1983. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM EACH SOURCE, PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.015 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

(1) LOT 4, (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 18, T 15 S, R 36 E, W.M.; 1100 FEET NORTH & 1100 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

(2) SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 36, T 15 S, R 35 E, W.M.; 1000 FEET NORTH & 1500 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 36.

(3) LOT 7, SECTION 1, T 16 S, R 35 E, W.M.; 300 FEET SOUTH & 1300 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 31.

(4) LOT 5, SECTION 1, T 16 S, R 35 E, W.M.; 2300 FEET SOUTH & 1500 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 1

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the places of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
