## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CALVIN, SALLY AND DAVID KRAHMER ROUTE 4, BOX 76 CORNELIUS, OREGON 97113 KENNETH AND BONNIE PETERSON 10155 SW JURGENS LANE TUALATIN, OREGON 97062

confirms the right to use the waters of THE TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATING 3.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 17175. The date of priority is JULY 31, 1946. This right is limited to 0.04 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44, T 2 S, R 1 W, W.M.; 530 FEET NORTH AND 1010 FEET EAST FROM THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 3.0 ACRES
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 44
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBRUARY 25, 1991, and together with Certificate 65343, supersedes Certificate 31526, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
