CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E.H. PRATT
HAINES, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH POWDER RIVER, a tributary of POWDER RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 43 ACRES AND DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at Page 252. The dates of priority are 1887 FOR 37 ACRES AND 1904 FOR 6 ACRES.

The use is limited to 1.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM MARCH 1st TO JULY 1st AND 0.54 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM JULY 1st TO OCTOBER 1st; THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED DURING EACH IRRIGATION SEASON NOT TO EXCEED 108 ACRE-FEET, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 7 S, R 38 E, W.M.; MANSFIELD DITCH - 3910 FEET SOUTH AND 2900 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 19.

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 18, T 7 S, R 38 E, W.M.; BULGER DITCH - 730 FEET NORTH AND 1370 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 19.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 1505, State Record of Water Right Certificates, as modified by provisions of an order of the State Engineer entered January 14, 1940, approving Transfer Application U-5, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 3, 1992, approving Transfer Applications 6403 and 6635.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
