confirms the right to use the waters of THE UMATILLA RIVER, a tributary of THE COLUMBIA RIVER, for LOG DECK SPRINKLING AND INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit 14412. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1940. This right is limited to 0.52 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 2 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 1287 FEET SOUTH AND 1023 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SW 1/4 NE 1/4
NW 1/4 SE 1/4
NE 1/4 SE 1/4

SECTION 9

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The former log pond located in SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 9, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W.M., no longer have any use under this right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 27, 1990, and supersedes Certificate 13679, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
