CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of COAST FORK OF WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 37.4 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 27736. The date of priority is DECEMBER 1, 1961. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of diversion together with that diverted at the original diversion shall not exceed 0.47 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, T 18 S, R 3 W, W.M.: 2450 FEET NORTH AND 270 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 12, T 18 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 2450 FEET NORTH AND 270 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 12; AND NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 12, T 18 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 1600 FEET NORTH AND 800 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 3.6 ACRES  
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 7.7 ACRES  
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 14.5 ACRES  
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 11.6 ACRES  
SECTION 12  
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

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The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 8, 1987, and together with certificate 56507, supersedes certificate 35873, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
