CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOLORES M. AND GARY L. LISMAN

JACKSONVILLE, OREGON 97530

confirms the right to use the waters of the APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR, constructed under Permit R-7810, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for the purpose of the SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 1.4 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit 46088. The date of priority is AUGUST 14, 1981. This right is limited to 4.0 ACRE-FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, if available at the original point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

S 1/2 SE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 40 S, R 4 W, W.M.; APPLGATE DAM.

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 39 S, R 3 W, W.M.; REPUMP - 1573 FEET NORTH AND 170 FEET EAST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract 1-07-10-W0406 between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, or a satisfactory replacement, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The right shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.4 ACRES
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

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The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 31, 1989, and supersedes Certificate 56328, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
