CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LORENE P. SCRIBNER
ROUTE 1, BOX 2203
BANDON, OREGON 97411

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE SUMPS in the BILLS CREEK (FERRY CREEK) BASIN for IRRIGATION, HARVESTING OF CRANBERRIES AND FROST CONTROL OF 7.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2778. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 6, 1964. This right is limited to 0.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND SHALL BE LIMITED TO A DIVERSION OF NOT TO EXCEED 0.18 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 0.21 CFS FOR FROST CONTROL AND 0.48 CFS FOR HARVESTING or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The sumps are located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, T 28 S, R 14 W, W.M.; SUMPS LOCATED: 360 FEET EAST AND 150 FEET SOUTH; 260 FEET WEST AND 40 FEET SOUTH; 80 FEET WEST AND 1020 FEET SOUTH; ALL FROM THE CENTER 1/4 SECTION 31.

The amount of water diverted for CRANBERRY OPERATIONS, together with amounts secured under any other rights existing for the same lands, is limited as follows: For temperature control, 0.15 cubic foot per second per acre; For flood harvesting or pest control, 0.05 cubic foot per second per acre; For irrigation of cranberries, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. For the irrigation of any other crop, ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second and 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4	3.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	4.3 ACRES
SECTION 31	
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 14 WEST, W.M.	

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 28, 1990 and supersedes Certificate 36965, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The purpose for this change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION IS TO ALLOW THE QUANTITY OF WATER FOR EACH USE UNDER THE SUBJECT WATER RIGHT TO BE APPROPRIATED FROM ANY COMBINATION OF THE 3 SUMPS.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
