CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VERLIN DUANE MILLS

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.9 ACRE.

This right has been perfected under Permit 22742. The date of priority is JULY 29, 1953. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION: NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 19, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1750 FEET NORTH 1075 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 19, T 30 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH AND 1370 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 0.9 ACRE  
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43  
SECTION 19  
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 16, 1985, and together with certificate 53615, supersedes certificate 43559, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
