CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID M. AND SARA K. WELCH, ROBERT K. AND MARY SCOTT HAMMONS, TRUMAN D.
AND IDELLE COLLINS, AND J.B. BRISTOW
SHADY COVE, OREGON 97539

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of
PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 12.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 8776. The date of priority is
NOVEMBER 7, 1928. This right is limited to 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of
diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 15 FOR WELCH AND COLLINS; LOT 4,
SECTION 10 FOR HAMMONS; ALL WITHIN T 34 S, R 1 W, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to
a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its
equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each
year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is
as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 49684, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 27, 1990, approving Transfer Application 6369, and entered May 4, 1992, approving Transfer Application 6375.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
