CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of RICKREALL CREEK AND HAYDEN SLOUGH, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 78.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 15237. The date of priority is APRIL 6, 1942. This right is limited to 0.99 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 35 (RICKREALL CREEK), SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 25, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 36 (HAYDEN SOUGH), ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN SHAW DLC 60, T 7 S, R 4 2, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
