CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES F. AND LURLINE COONAN
C-2 CATTLE COMPANY
LAKE CREEK, OREGON 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of WASSON CREEK AND WASSON CREEK EQUALIZATION RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5395, a tributary of NORTH FORK LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, for the purpose of RECREATION.

This right has been perfected under Permit 34033. The date of priority is DECEMBER 10, 1968. This right is limited to 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 26, T 36 S, R 2 E, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 350 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 26.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 2 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
