CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JAMES A. AND BETTY L. TIFFEE ROUTE 1, BOX 1 TILLER OREGON 97484

confirms the right to use the waters of CEDAR CREEK, a tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE IN AREA.

The right has been perfected under Permit 47527. The date of priority is JANUARY 31, 1983. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 30 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 440 FEET SOUTH AND 90 FEET EAST FROM NW 1/16 CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
