CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KENNETH AND LUCILE PECK CLARKS CANYON ROAD LEXINGTON, OREGON 97839

confirms the right to use the waters of CLARKS CREEK, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 24.75 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50253. The date of priority is APRIL 4, 1988. This right is limited to 0.40 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 4, T 2 S, R 25 E, W.M; 635 FEET SOUTH AND 635 FEET EAST FROM CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 7.61 ACRES SW 1/4 NE 1/4 7.00 ACRES NE 1/4 NW 1/4 8.68 ACRES SE 1/4 NW 1/4 1.46 ACRES SECTION 4

TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 25 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
