CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL ASCUENA and ARTHUR GREENFIELD
ROUTE 1, BOX 134 - J9, K2
PENDLETON, OREGON 97801

confirms the right to use the waters of 3 WELLS in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATING 2.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-5068. The date of priority is MAY 27, 1970. This right is limited to 0.03 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING; 0.02 CFS FROM WELL 2 AND 0.01 CFS FROM WELL 3, WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN SUPPLY FROM WELL 2 TO BE MADE UP BY AN APPROPRIATION FROM WELL 4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 7, T 2 N, R 33 E, W.M.; WELL 2 - 2110 FEET SOUTH AND 3040 FEET WEST; WELL 3 - 2430 FEET SOUTH AND 3040 FEET WEST; BOTH FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 8; WELL 4 - 1990 FEET SOUTH AND 2430 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right is further limited to the appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with the existing surface water rights of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 2 NORTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.		

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 49141, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 14, 1992, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
