## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CASPER AND MATHILDA OTT 3568 BLAUCHET AVENUE ST. PAUL, OREGON 97137

confirms the right to use the waters of the WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 90.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 34822. The date of priority is DECEMBER 15, 1969. This right is limited to 1.13 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within CLASSENS DLC 69, SECTION 13, T 4 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 490 FEET NORTH AND 590 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF ACCOLTI DLC 68.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
