## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST P.O. BOX 1008 ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE RIVER, a tributary of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, for POTABLE AND SANITARY (DOMESTIC) USES AT CAMPGROUND AND PICNIC GROUND.

This right was perfected under Permit 48556. The date of priority is OCTOBER 5, 1982. This right is limited to 0.1 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 27 S, R 2 W, W.M.; 1750 FEET SOUTH AND 1300 FEET WEST FROM THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 9
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
