CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of CABIN AND HUCKLEBERRY SPRINGS, both tributaries of JACK CREEK, for the purpose of LIVESTOCK WATERING.

This right has been perfected under Permit 48627. The date of priority is MARCH 18, 1983. This right is limited to 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.005 CFS FROM EACH SPRING, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SPRING 1 - NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 27 S, R 10 E, W.M.;  
2240 FEET NORTH AND 330 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 28;  
SPRING 2 - NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 36, T 27 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 1850 FEET  
NORTH AND 140 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 36.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 - CABIN SPRING  
SECTION 28  
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 - HUCKLEBERRY SPRING  
SECTION 36  
TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. This right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
