CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO UNNAMED SPRINGS (SL-22 & SL-26), tributaries of HAWKINS CREEK AND BEAR CREEK, for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 50062. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 26, 1983. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.01 CFS FROM EACH SOURCE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

(1) NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 5, T 10 S, R 32 E, W.M.; 1980 FEET NORTH AND 2310 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 5.

(2) NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 10 S, R 32 E, W.M.; 925 FEET SOUTH AND 1055 FEET WEST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
SECTION 5

NE 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 9  
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
