This right was perfected under Permit 49338. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 22, 1983. This right is limited to 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 10, T 41 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 924 FEET SOUTH AND 858 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 10.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
SECTION 10
TOWNSHIP 41 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
