CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 0.4 ACRE.

The right has been confirmed by the decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County the decree is of record at Salem in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at page 461, entered November 16, 1956. The date of priority is 1863.

The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT OF WATER PER SECOND measured at the point of diversion from the river, the TROWBRIDGE DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, shall be limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre from April 1 to September 30; further limited to 1 acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1, and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter, and limited to 5 acre-feet per acre per season, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 0.4 ACRE
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This Certificate is to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE authorized by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 5, 1985, approving Transfer Application 5651 and together with Certificate 53621 supersedes Certificate 51975, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
