CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 87.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 19266. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 14, 1950. This right is limited to 0.49 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW\(\frac{1}{3}\) NW\(\frac{1}{3}\), AS PROJECTED WITHIN BAILEY DLC 40, SECTION 5, T 30 S, R 5 W; 1060 FEET NORTH AND 1080 FEET EAST FROM THE E CORNER OF SECTION 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
