confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the WILLOW CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 27.2 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit G-9381. The dates of priority are APRIL 17, 1980, FOR 0.27 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND JULY 2, 1981, FOR 0.07 CFS. The right is limited to not more than 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 32, T 16 S, R 44 E, W.M.; 970 FEET NORTH AND 1120 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent and 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4 16.4 ACRES SE 1/4 NW 1/4 10.8 ACRES SECTION 32 TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 44 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
