CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CITY OF ASHLAND  
CITY HALL  
27½ MAIN STREET  
ASHLAND, OREGON 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of ASHLAND CREEK, a tributary of BEAR CREEK, for MUNICIPAL USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1864.

The use is limited to 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right and shall not exceed 0.08 cfs, **being limited to the irrigation season of each year.**

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 20, T 39 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 100 FEET NORTH AND 10 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 20.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ASHLAND  
SECTIONS 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17, AND 23  
TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.

The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the wateruser is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, AND USE HERETOFORE MADE OF THE WATER approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 21, 1978, and together with Certificate 46271, supersedes Certificate 16034, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
