confirms the right to use the waters of UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 27.4 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 29072. The date of priority is AUGUST 27, 1963. The right is limited to not more than 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old diversion, for the remaining lands, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right located at SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN WOODRUFF DLC 38, SECTION 18, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M. DIVERSION POINT LOCATED 470 FEET NORTH AND 6210 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER OF SECTION 13, T 26 S, R 7 W, W.M.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 60, SECTION 18, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 400 FEET NORTH AND 240 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the UMPQUA RIVER is more than 525 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND AT TIDEWATER.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4	1.3 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4	6.0 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4	2.3 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4	17.6 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4	0.2 ACRE

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The following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an Order of the Water Resources Director entered June 29, 1981, and together with Certificate 50359, supersedes Certificate 35531, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.
